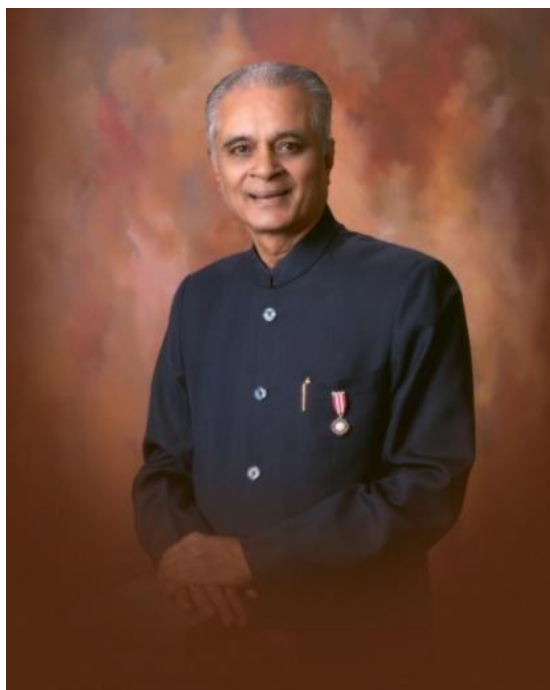

SET/ SITEEE Registration

A. SET/SITEE test registration process:

SET/ SITEEE 2026 will be conducted on two different dates. Please note these dates carefully:

Date of SET/ SITEEE 2026 and Time	
May 02,2026 (Saturday) and May 10,2026 (Sunday)	Time
SET	09.00 am to 10.00 am
SITEEE	11.30 am to 12.30 pm

A candidate can appear for upto two tests for SET and/or SITEEE 2026. If a candidate appears for more than one test, the higher score will be considered for the admission process. There will be no normalization. A rigorous process that has been statistically tested will be administered to ensure that unique types of questions are framed under a specific topic across the question papers. The normal spread will ensure that there is no unfair advantage to candidates who opt for any specific test / multiple tests. This will ensure the normalisation of the spread of questions across sections. Furthermore, the question papers will be normalised for the level of difficulty across all two tests. No correspondence regarding this will be entertained.

- **Candidates will be shortlisted for the Personal Interaction (PI) process based on his / her SET 2026 scores.**
- **Programme-wise ranks will be available in the candidate login portal after the final date for programme registration and fee payment. Ranks will only be displayed for programmes for which the candidate has registered and completed payment.**

The registration process is as follows:

1. Click on 'Register'.
2. Read all the Instructions carefully and then click on the 'Continue' button to accept the Terms and Conditions.
3. Fill in the details requested on the page displayed.
4. Click on 'Save and Continue'. An OTP will be sent to the mobile number and email id that you have entered.
5. Enter the 'OTP' and submit.
6. After successful registration, you will get an e-mail and SMS containing your SET/SITEEE ID and password. Use this SET/SITEEE ID for all communications regarding the SET/SITEEE 2026 entrance test / admission procedure.
7. Pay the SET/SITEEE entrance test registration fee of INR 2250 per test [government taxes would be additional as and when applicable]-non-transferable and non-refundable as per the instructions mentioned on the registration portal.
8. In addition to that, you are also expected to pay the non-refundable and non-transferable programme registration fee of INR 1000/- (government taxes would be additional as and when applicable) for each programme that you wish to apply for.
9. **Please note that payment of only the SET/SITEEE entrance test registration fee will not make you eligible for short listing/merit listing in any programme, regardless of your SET/SITEEE score. Both fees must be paid as per the instructions provided on the registration portal. Failure to pay the programme registration fee will result in your application not being considered for that programme. No communication will be entertained in this regard.**
10. If you have any queries, please log in to your SET/SITEEE ID and click on "**Raise A Query**" and generate a ticket. Generating a ticket is essential to resolve your query.
11. The modes of payment for the programme(s) registration fee is same as that for SET/SITEEE.
12. Candidate must declare and maintain a valid and unique email account and a mobile phone number throughout the admission process.
13. A candidate is required to fill in the correct information in the online registration form which corresponds to her/his credentials.
14. Register online on the website www.set-test.org (upto April 15,2026 (Wednesday)).
Note: No changes shall be permitted after the registration under any circumstances.
15. A candidate can appear for SET/SITEEE on both the dates **May 02,2026 (Saturday)** and **May 10,2026 (Sunday)**.
A candidate can appear for upto two tests for SET and/or SITEEE 2026. If a candidate appears for more than one

test, the higher score will be considered. Programme-wise ranks will be available in the candidate login portal after the final date for programme registration and fee payment. Ranks will only be displayed for programmes for which the candidate has registered and completed payment.

16. Please also note that if any information provided by a candidate is found to be incorrect, the University shall have right to cancel the candidature of that candidate.

For Engineering, if a candidate applies to seek admission on the basis of test other than SITEEE, he/she need not register for SITEEE; rather he/she may apply directly to the concerned institute through the institute website (<https://www.sitpune.edu.in/> , <https://sitnagpur.edu.in/> and <https://sithyd.siu.edu.in/>)

B. SET/SITEEE test registration fee payment process:

Pay the SET/SITEEE Test registration fee of **INR 2250 per test** (government taxes would be additional as and when applicable) (non-refundable and non-transferable) upto **April 15,2026 (Wednesday)** as per the instructions mentioned on the website (www.set-test.org) for Payment of SET/SITEEE Test registration fee.

In addition to that, you are also expected to pay the non-refundable and non-transferable programme registration fee of **INR 1000/- (government taxes would be additional as and when applicable) for each programme** that you wish to apply for.

Please note that payment of only the SET/SITEEE entrance test registration fee will not make you eligible for shortlisting / merit listing in any programme, regardless of your SET/SITEEE score. ***Persons with Disabilities (PwD)** candidate means a candidate having any of the disabilities in accordance with the Persons with Disabilities Act – 1995 and as per revised Gazette of India Registered no: DL – (N)04/0007/2003-16 dated December 28, 2016.

Process to be followed for Persons with Disabilities (PwD):

- The candidate applying for the entrance tests/admission in the Persons with Disabilities (PwD), selects the type of disability available in the PwD options on the portal.
- A Persons with Disabilities (PwD) candidate is required to upload his/her copy of Disability Certificate issued by Competent Government Medical Authority and Unique Disability ID (UD ID) Card at the time of registration for entrance/admission of SIU to ascertain percentage and the type of the disability.

- The Medical Superintendent, SUHRC through Medical Board shall ascertain the genuineness of the said documents. Once the documents are found authentic and correct by the Medical Board, SUHRC, his/her eligibility will be certified under the PwD category.

Note – If a candidate selects a Persons with Disabilities (PwD) in the Registration form and s/he requires scribe/writer facility please note SIU will not be providing scribe/writer. The candidate has to make her/his own arrangement for scribe/writer. The qualification of scribe/writer should be a maximum 9th standard candidate or a maximum 9th standard passed candidate (Or Appearing 10th Standard). The scribe should not have completed studies beyond the 9th standard. **Candidate should send the request to info@set-test.org , on or before April 15,2026 (Wednesday) in case scribe/writer is required.**

As per SIU norms, a Persons with Disabilities (PwD) is provided with 20 minutes of compensatory time for every 60 minutes of test.

1. A candidate applying under any of the reserved category (Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribes/ Person with Disabilities (PwD)/ Kashmiri Migrants/ Children/wards of Defence Personnel) are mandatorily required to upload and submit relevant document issued by competent authority. Any participation at any stage of admission process by such candidate is purely provisional and always subject to verification and authentication of such relevant document.
2. In case a candidate falls under more than one of the above categories (e.g. Scheduled Caste as well as Persons with Disabilities (PwD) or any other combination), S/he would need to select any one Category (i.e. Either Scheduled Caste OR Persons with Disabilities (PwD) in the case of example mentioned above) at the time of filling up the registration form. The category selected by the candidate at the time of filling the registration form will be considered to be his category for the entire admission process and his benefits and entitlements shall be according to such selected category. S/he will not be able to claim benefit under the other category/s at any stage of admission on any account whatsoever.
3. Please also note that if any information provided by the candidate in respect of his category is found to be incorrect, the University shall have right to cancel the candidature of such candidate.

I. Reservation of seats for Nagpur Domicile (SCMS, Nagpur and SIT, Nagpur):

Reservation of seats for Nagpur Domicile (SCMS, Nagpur and SIT Nagpur) (25% of seats within the sanctioned intake- Only in case of Constituents at Off-Campus center, Nagpur)

In accordance with Clause A of Schedule C of the Lease Deed signed between Nagpur Municipal Corporation, Nagpur and Symbiosis, Pune on 4th September, 2017, the University has reserved 25% seats against the approved intake in each programme offered at the Off-campus Centre of the University at Nagpur for Nagpur Domiciled candidates.

The definition for Nagpur Domicile is:

Nagpur Domiciled' means candidates, who are domiciled in Nagpur for a period of 5(five) years as on the date of commencement of the academic year and who (a) are or will be graduates or students of Nagpur University, **and/ or** (b) are recipients of school certificates from the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, the Council of Indian School Certificate Examinations, and/ or the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE)/ ICSE Board.

While giving admission under the Nagpur domicile category-

- **Residence Criterion:** Resident of Nagpur Urban (five continuous or intermittent years) is mandatory,
- **Educational Criterion:** The candidate should fulfil one of the following criteria

(a) graduate or pursuing graduation from Nagpur University

- OR-

(b) school certificates (10th and 12th) from (i) Maharashtra Board, (ii) CISCE (iii) CBSE, (iv) ICSE (*It simply means 10th and 12th passed certificates from other State Boards and foreign school boards are NOT accepted*)

Please bring/keep the following documents with you for the Personal Interview (PI) if you are shortlisted. Kindly note that candidates who fail to present both documents will not be permitted to participate in the PI process and will be deemed ineligible for admission. No correspondence on this matter will be entertained.

J. Process for International Candidates:

The Symbiosis Centre for International Education (SCIE)

Admissions of international students are centralized for all the constituent institutes of Symbiosis International Deemed University and are routed through the Symbiosis Centre for International Education (SCIE).

SCIE earmarks 20% of the total intake of the respective program for international students which include, Foreign Nationals (FN), Person of Indian Origin (PIO) Card Holders, Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) Card Holders, and Non-Resident Indians (NRI).

Foreign National (FN):

A student is eligible to apply as a Foreign National (FN) if he/she is a citizen of any country other than India and holds a foreign passport.

Person of Indian Origin (PIO):

As per the Government of India notification dated 9th January 2015, all the existing Persons of Indian Origin cardholders registered as such shall be deemed to be Overseas Citizens of India cardholders.

Overseas Citizen of India (OCI):

A student is eligible to apply as OCI if he/she is granted with Overseas Citizenship of India and has an OCI card.

Non-Resident Indian (NRI):

A student is eligible to apply as a Non-Resident Indian (NRI) if he/she has appeared for either 10th or 10+2 (equivalent to the Indian 10th or 12th) examination outside India. It is mandatory for one of the two qualifying examinations to be given outside India. Please refer www.scie.ac.in for more details.

To assist candidates with their application to Symbiosis International (Deemed University) a detailed stepwise procedure is available on www.scie.ac.in interested candidates can apply online through the user-friendly online application portal. 3. Admit Card along with **Original** Photo Identity proof should be carried to the Test Centre at the time of the test. An acceptable photo identity is any one of the following:

- Driving license.
- Voter ID Card.
- Pan Card
- AADHAR Card (UID)
- College ID Card

Note: Soft copy of identity proof will not be accepted.

4. An authorized person will verify and authenticate your Admit Card against the photo-id on the day of the test. Please preserve this authenticated Admit Card for further PI processes.

5. Candidates should note that an authenticated Admit Card is an important document without which the candidate will not be permitted to appear for further admission processes of SIU. If the Authenticated Admit card is lost, **a duplicate Authenticated Admit Card will not be issued**. It should be retained till the admission process is over.

Shortlisting and Admission Process

Shortlisting:

Candidates will be shortlisted for Personal Interaction (PI) process based on their respective Entrance Test marks. Please check the respective institute website for information and dates of Personal Interaction (PI).

The further admission process is conducted separately for each programme by each Institute. The cut-off for shortlisting is also calculated separately for each programme. Based on her/his overall SET score, a particular candidate may get shortlisted for more than one programme. In such a scenario the candidate is expected to participate in the PI for each programme separately. Programme-wise ranks will be available in the candidate login portal after the final date for programme registration and fee payment. Ranks will only be displayed for programmes for which the candidate has registered and completed payment.

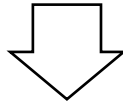

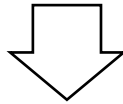

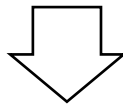
