



Since 2018, "SET – General" is known as Symbiosis Entrance Test (SET) and "SET – Engineering" as SIT Engineering Entrance Exam (SITEEE). These are conducted in Computer Based Test (CBT) mode across various cities of India.

SIU announces the four-year degree programme with multiple entry and exit options as envisioned in the NEP 2020\*. The highlights of the new programme offerings are as under

If shortlisted, he/she would then need to attend the further admission process conducted by each of these institutes individually.

#### **SET/SITEEE Registration**

#### A. SET/SITEE test registration process

SET/ SITEEE 2026 will be conducted on two different dates. Please note these dates carefully:

A candidate can appear for upto two tests for SET and/or SITEEE 2026. If a candidate appears for more than one test, the higher score will be considered for the final percentile calculation. There will be no normalization. A rigorous process that has been statistically tested will be administered to ensure that unique types of questions are framed under a specific topic across the question papers. The normal spread will ensure that there is no unfair advantage to candidates who opt for any specific test / multiple tests. This will ensure the normalisation of the spread of questions across sections. Furthermore, the question papers will be normalised for the level of difficulty across all two tests. No correspondence regarding this will be entertained.

From 2018 onwards, "SET General" is known as Symbiosis Entrance Test (SET) and "SET-Engineering" as SIT Engineering Entrance Exam (SITEEE).

#### The registration process is as follows:

- 1. Click on 'Register'.
- 2. Read all the Instructions carefully and then click on the 'Continue' button to accept the Terms and Conditions.
- 3. Fill in the details requested on the page displayed.
- 4. Click on 'Save & Continue'. An OTP will be sent to the mobile number and email id that you have entered.
- 5. Enter the 'OTP' and submit.
- 6. After successful registration, you will get an e-mail & SMS containing your SET/SITEEE ID and password. Use this SET/SITEEE ID for all communications regarding the SET/SITEEE 2026 entrance test / admission procedure.
- 7. Pay the SET/SITEEE entrance test registration fee of INR 2250 per test [government taxes would be additional as and when applicable]-non-transferable and non-refundable as per the instructions mentioned on the Registration Portal.
- 8. In addition to that, you are also expected to pay the non-refundable and non-transferable programme registration fee of INR 1000/- (government taxes would be additional as and when applicable) for each programme that you wish to apply for.
- 9. Please note that payment of only the SET/SITEEE entrance test registration fee will not make you eligible for shortlisting in any programme, regardless of your SET/SITEEE score. Both fees must be paid as per the instructions provided on the registration portal. Failure to pay the programme registration fee will result in your application not being considered for that programme. No communication will be entertained in this regard.
- 10. If you have any queries, please log in to your SET/SITEEE ID and click on "Raise A Query" and generate a ticket. Generating a ticket is essential to resolve your query.
- 11. The modes of payment for the programme(s) registration fee is same as that for SET/SITEEE.
- 12. Candidate must declare and maintain a valid and unique email account and a mobile phone number

- throughout the admission process.
- 13. A candidate is required to fill in the correct information in the online registration form which corresponds to her/his credentials.
- 14. Register online on the website <u>www.set-test.org</u> (upto **April 10,2026 (Friday)**. Note: No changes shall be permitted after the registration under any circumstances.
- 15. A candidate can appear for SET/SITEEE on both the dates May 02,2026 (Saturday) and May 10,2026 (Sunday). If a candidate appears for more than one test, the higher score will be considered for the final percentile calculation.
- 16. Please also note that if any information provided by a candidate is found to be incorrect, the University shall have right to cancel the candidature of that candidate.

#### **General Terms & Conditions:**

- 1. Upload your latest scanned colour passport size photo at the time of Online Registration. (Your photograph should not be more than 06 months old).
- 2. Ensure that the information you have filled is accurate. No changes shall be permitted after the registration under any circumstances. Candidates are fully and solely responsible to provide correct information during the application process. If it is found that any information provided by the candidate at the time of filling / submitting the application form is not true, SIU has the right to cancel the application or admission, at any stage, in accordance with its rules and regulations. Any direct or indirect attempt to influence the management and employees of the Institute will lead to automatic disqualification of the candidate.

- 4. Candidate should note that SET/SITEEE 2026 is only the first step. Each Symbiosis institute has its subsequent independent admission process post shortlisting.
- 5. SET/SITEEE Test registration fee and programme registration fee of the Institute is **non-refundable** and **non-transferable**.
- 6. For Engineering, if a candidate applies to seek admission on the basis of test other than SITEEE, he/she need not register for SITEEE; rather he/she may apply directly to the concerned institute through the institute website (https://www.sitpune.edu.in/, https://sitnagpur.edu.in/ and https://sithyd.siu.edu.in/)

#### B. SET/SITEEE test registration fee payment process

- iii. Demand Draft.

Pay the SET/SITEEE Test registration fee of **INR 2250 per test** (government taxes would be additional as and when applicable) upto **April 10,2026** (**Friday**) as per the instructions mentioned on the website (<u>www.set-test.org</u>) for Payment of SET/SITEEE Test registration fee.

In addition to that, you are also expected to pay the non-refundable and non-transferable programme registration fee of INR 1000/- (government taxes would be additional as and when applicable) for each programme that you wish to apply for.

Please note that payment of only the SET/SITEEE entrance test registration fee will not make you eligible for shortlisting in any programme, regardless of your SET/SITEEE score. Both fees must be paid as per the instructions provided on the registration portal. Failure to pay the programme registration fee will result in your application not being considered for that programme. No communication will be entertained in this regard.

For disputes between the candidate and the **Symbiosis Test Secretariat**, the candidate should first send an email to <a href="registrar@siu.edu.in">registrar@siu.edu.in</a> with details about his/her grievance. If the candidate is not satisfied with the decision of the Registrar, he/she can appeal to the Ombudsman of the University. - 6. **SET/SITEEE 2026 Score will be valid only for admission to selected programmes of Symbiosis International (Deemed University) (SIU) for the academic year 2026-27**. Admissions to the select programmes at SIU are strictly based on merit, assessment of individual performance in the respective Entrance Test for Undergraduate Studies and other processes prescribed by the University.
- 7. SET/SITEEE 2026 Result will be declared on May 20,2026 (Wednesday), on <a href="www.set-test.org">www.set-test.org</a> and will be available up till June 19,2026 (Friday).

A candidate is required to make separate non-refundable and non-transferable payment of INR 1000/- (government taxes would be additional as and when applicable) per programme per institute at this stage.

Please note that payment of only the SET/SITEEE entrance test registration fee will not make you eligible for shortlisting in any programme, regardless of your SET/SITEEE score. Both fees must be paid as per the instructions provided on the registration portal. Failure to pay the programme registration fee will result in your application not being considered for that programme. No communication will be entertained in this regard.

If candidates want to pay programme payment through Demand Draft, make Demand Draft of INR 1000/-(government taxes would be additional as and when applicable) for **each programme** in the name of "**Symbiosis Test Secretariat**".

In compliance to Government directives on disability guidelines issued by the office of the Chief Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities vide Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, New Delhi notification no. 16-18/97 dated 01st June 2001 and University Grants Commission Notification No. F.6-1/2006 (CPP-II/SCT) dated 30/09/2009, SIU has made provision of reserving 3% seats for Persons with Disabilities (PwD)candidates in all the programmes offered by all the Institutes of SIU.

\*Persons with Disabilities (PwD) candidate means a candidate having any of the disabilities in accordance with the Persons with Disabilities Act – 1995 and as per revised Gazette of India Registered no: DL – (N)04/0007/2003-16 dated December 28, 2016.

#### Process to be followed for Persons with Disabilities (PwD):

- The candidate applying for the entrance tests/admission in the Persons with Disabilities (PwD), selects the type of disability available in the PwD options on the portal.
- A Persons with Disabilities (PwD) candidate is required to upload his/her copy of Disability
  Certificate issued by Competent Government Medical Authority the and Unique Disability ID (UD
  ID) Card at the time of registration for entrance/admission of SIU to ascertain percentage and the
  type of the disability.
- The Medical Superintendent, SUHRC through Medical Board shall ascertain the genuineness of the said documents. Once the documents are found authentic and correct by the Medical Board, SUHRC, his/her eligibility will be certified under the PwD category.

**Note** – If a candidate selects a Persons with Disabilities (PwD) in the Registration form and s/he requires scribe/writer facility please note SIU will not be providing scribe/writer. The candidate has to make her/his own arrangement for scribe/writer. The qualification of scribe/writer should be a maximum 9th standard candidate or a maximum 9th standard passed candidate (Or Appearing 10th Standard). The scribe should not have completed studies beyond the 9th standard. Candidate should send the request to <a href="mailto:info@set-test.org">info@set-test.org</a>, on or before April 10,2026 (Friday) in case scribe/writer is required.

As per SIU norms, a Persons with Disabilities (PwD) is provided with 20 minutes of compensatory time for every 60 minutes of test.

- 1. A candidate applying under any of the reserved category (Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribes/ Person with Disabilities (PwD)/ Kashmiri Migrants/ Children/wards of Defence Personnel) are mandatorily required to upload and submit relevant document issued by competent authority. Any participation at any stage of admission process by such candidate is purely provisional and always subject to verification and authentication of such relevant document.
- 2. In case a candidate falls under more than one of the above categories (e.g. Scheduled Caste as well as Persons with Disabilities (PwD) or any other combination), S/he would need to select any one Category (i.e. Either Scheduled Caste OR Persons with Disabilities (PwD) in the case of example mentioned above) at the time of filling up the registration form. The category selected by the candidate at the time of filling the registration form will be considered to be his category for the entire admission process and his benefits and entitlements shall be according to such selected category. S/he will not be able to claim benefit under the other category/s at any stage of admission on any account whatsoever.
- 3. Please also note that if any information provided by the candidate in respect of his category is found to be incorrect, the University shall have right to cancel the candidature of such candidate.
  - I. Reservation of seats for Nagpur Domicile (SCMS, Nagpur and SIT, Nagpur):

Reservation of seats for Nagpur Domicile (SCMS, Nagpur and SIT Nagpur) (25% of seats within the sanctioned intake- Only in case of Constituents at Off-Campus center, Nagpur)

In accordance with Clause A of Schedule C of the Lease Deed signed between Nagpur Municipal Corporation, Nagpur and Symbiosis, Pune on 4th September, 2017, the University has reserved 25% seats against the approved intake in each programme offered at the Off-campus Centre of the University at Nagpur for Nagpur Domiciled candidates.

#### The definition for Nagpur Domicile is:

**Nagpur Domiciled'** means candidates, who are domiciled in Nagpur for a period of 5(five) years as on the date of commencement of the academic year and who (a) are or will be graduates or students of Nagpur University, **and/or** (b) are recipients of school certificates from the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, the Council of Indian School Certificate Examinations, and/ or the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE)/ ICSE Board.

While giving admission under the Nagpur domicile category-

- Residence Criterion: Resident of Nagpur Urban (five continuous or intermittent years) is mandatory,
- Educational Criterion: The candidate should fulfil one of the following criteria
- (a) graduate or pursuing graduation from Nagpur University
- OR-
- (b) school certificates (10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>) from (i) Maharashtra Board, (ii) CISCE (iii) CBSE, (iv) ICSE (It simply means 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> passed certificates from other State Boards and foreign

#### school boards are NOT accepted)

#### J. Process for International Candidates:

#### The Symbiosis Centre for International Education (SCIE)

Admissions of international students are centralized for all the constituent institutes of Symbiosis International Deemed University and are routed through the Symbiosis Centre for International Education (SCIE).

SCIE earmarks 20% of the total intake of the respective program for international students which include, Foreign Nationals (FN), Person of Indian Origin (PIO) Card Holders, Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) Card Holders, and Non-Resident Indians (NRI).

#### Foreign National (FN):

A student is eligible to apply as a Foreign National (FN) if he/she is a citizen of any country other than India and holds a foreign passport.

#### Person of Indian Origin (PIO):

As per the Government of India notification dated 9th January 2015, all the existing Persons of Indian Origin cardholders registered as such shall be deemed to be Overseas Citizens of India cardholders.

#### Overseas Citizen of India (OCI):

A student is eligible to apply as OCI if he/she is granted with Overseas Citizenship of India and has an OCI card.

#### **Non-Resident Indian (NRI):**

A student is eligible to apply as a Non-Resident Indian (NRI) if he/she has appeared for either 10th or 10+2 (equivalent to the Indian 10th or 12th) examination outside India. It is mandatory for one of the two qualifying examinations to be given outside India. Please refer www.scie.ac.in for more details.

Admit Cards will be available from April 24,2026 (Friday) for SET/SITEEE Test 01 and from April 30,2026 (Thursday) for SET/SITEEE Test 02. Black and white printouts will not be accepted.
- 2. Please ensure that your latest passport size, colour photograph is pasted on the Admit Card at the place provided for before appearing for the test (Your photograph should not be more than six months old).
- 3. Admit Card along with **Original** Photo Identity proof should be carried to the Test Centre at the time of the test. An acceptable photo identity is any one of the following:
- Passport.
- Driving license.
- Voter ID Card.
- Pan Card
- AADHAR Card (UID)

#### Note: Soft copy of identity proof will not be accepted.

- 4. An authorized person will verify and authenticate your Admit Card against the photo-id on the day of the test. Please preserve this authenticated Admit Card for further PI processes.
- 5. Candidates should note that an authenticated Admit Card is an important document without which the candidate will not be permitted to appear for further admission processes of SIU. If the Authenticated Admit card is lost, a duplicate Authenticated Admit Card will not be issued. It should be retained till the admission process is over.

#### **Shortlisting and Admission Process**

#### **Shortlisting:**

Candidates will be shortlisted for Personal Interaction (PI) process based on their respective Entrance Test marks. Please check the respective institute website for information and dates of Personal Interaction (PI).

The further admission process is conducted separately for each programme by each Institute. The cutoff for shortlisting is also calculated separately for each programme. Based on her/his overall SET/SITEEE percentile, a particular candidate may get shortlisted for more than one programme. In such a scenario the candidate is expected to participate in the PI for each programme separately.

Please note that institutes shortlist candidates who have appeared for the entrance test and paid for the programme for the subsequent process based on their own criteria, which may be independent of each other. The process may include any or all of the following, Writing Ability Test (WAT), Group Discussion (GD), Studio Test (ST) and Personal Interview (PI). Performance in SET/SITEEE is an important component in the admission process. Institutes may additionally use other factors such as but not limited to the previous academic performance of the candidates, relevant work experience, gender and academic diversity and other similar inputs in their merit listing process. Weightages allocated to these parameters may vary across institutes/programmes.
